Netcare eReferral has been updated to enhance functionality for users. New features include:

- Name changes: Advice requests are now known as eConsults, while consult requests are called referrals
- FAST: Referrals can be sent to the Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment program using a simplified search function
- User guides: Updated guides are available via the eReferral Learning Centre
- Connect Care: Access to Netcare has been enhanced. More information.
