Patient will be contacted within 1–7 days depending on assessed urgency



available to adults with life-limiting illness wherever they live in the Calgary zone, to help you with symptom management, complex advance care planning, hospice placement, family/caregiver support etc.

Rural: Patients living in rural Calgary zone need to be admitted to Integrated Home Care prior to receiving a palliative care consult.

Palliative care consult service – one-time consult $\sqrt{\text{Urban palliative home care}}$ – ongoing case management required for complex holistic palliative symptoms for adults with life limiting illness in the city of Calgary. Care team may include RN case manager, palliative physician consultants, allied health, spiritual care consultant, and vendor services. Palliative care will not take over as most responsible provider but will provide ongoing support to the family physician to manage care.

EMERGENCY ADULT PALLIATIVE CARE

Patient NEEDS immediate support, i.e. imminently dying/symptom crisis



Call **911** for:

- EMS Palliative and End of Life Care Assess, Treat and Refer Program (non-lights and sirens paramedic team provides support at home). Follow script: "I require EMS assistance for a palliative care patient. I would like to request the EMS palliative end of life assess, treat and refer program."
- ✓ Emergency transportation to hospital.
